

MISSIONS REPORT

The Mission House continues to provide practical, emotional, and spiritual support to Tallassee and the surrounding area. It is not unusual for 20 people to be served any given Wednesday. Relationships have grown with those served during the last 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ years we've been open, with blessings provided to those served and serving.

The partnership with the Heart of Alabama Food Bank has proven to be a positive addition to the food offerings at the Mission House. Approximately 250 pounds of food are purchased monthly at 18 cents a pound at the HAFB in Montgomery. The food is distributed into individual bags for our guests each week. Last month food was provided to 50 people (this is a duplicated count, as some guests pick up a bag of food each week).

Thanks to the Trustees for closing in the garage with a wall and locked door. This has been so helpful in making larger items like furniture and beds available for our guests. One guest received a chest of drawers so he would not have to lay his clothes in piles on the floor. One couple new to Tallassee had no furniture and received some bedroom and living room furniture. A church volunteer actually transported the furniture to their home.

Thanks to the church community for the abundant donations of clothing, linens, housewares, medical equipment, dishes, pot and pans, hygiene items, and more. The volunteers at the Mission House are challenged to keep up with deluge of donations, but this is what makes the Mission House meet the needs of so many.

We said goodbye to one of our weekly volunteers, Carole Rhodes, as she moved to another state to be with some of her family members. We will miss her.

We would like to encourage all church members to continue to spread the word of the love and support provided through our Mission House of First Methodist Church. Remind teachers, counselors, nurses, medical staff, policemen, firemen, and others to connect those in need to our Mission House. It is open every Wednesday between 9 and 1 and is available as needed for emergencies. Calls or texts are responded to during waking hours at 334-640-5760. Our mission: Love One Another.
