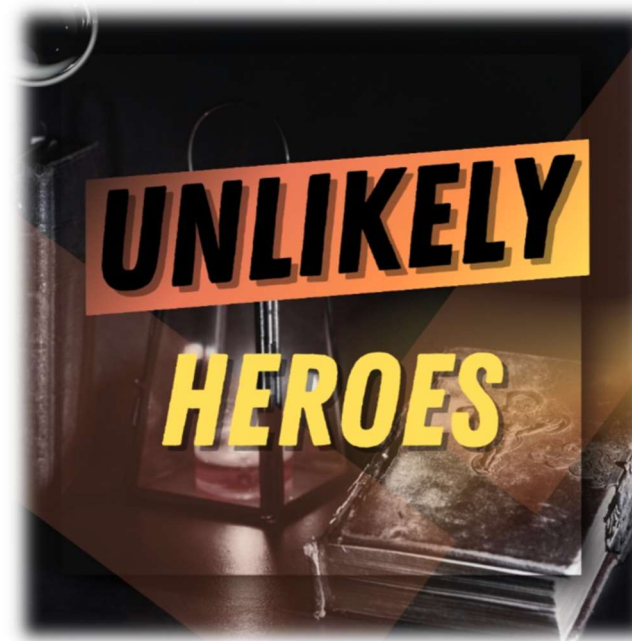
CHURCH-WIDE TOWN HALL MEETING REGARDING PROPOSED COVERED WALKWAY
